- Poetry / Fiction / Nonfiction / Playwrighting - five copies of up to 10 pages
- Musicians - 1 CD
- Other / Performance Art - 1 dvd

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications will be reviewed by a panel of Lanesboro Arts Center staff, working artists and community representatives. Successful applications will address the following criteria:

1. Quality of the work samples submitted
2. Value of the proposed project to the artist's career and to the community
3. Creativity and innovation of integrating art into the community
4. Ability to accomplish the project outlined in the time requested

Decisions are made by our panel and are announced 45 days after the application deadline. Lanesboro Arts Center encourages applicants of all disciplines to apply for Artist Residencies.
